## Foreword

The European Union is in its consecutive seventh year of economic growth. That is good news for our businesses and good news for our citizens employed in them and using their services.

But the EU must do even more. We need to sustain growth and prepare for the future. That means above all an economy that taps the potential of digitalisation and makes the transition to sustainability.

SMEs must be at the heart of our economy. They represent 99% of the EU companies in the non-financial business sector and employ two thirds of our workers.

Strengthening SMEs is one of the priorities of the new Commission. As the new Commission President Ursula Von der Leyen said in her political guidelines,<sup>1</sup> "They represent everything that is good in our economy".

This is why the new Commission will be adopting a dedicated SME strategy to ensure they can thrive by reducing red tape and improving their access to the market. This will mean using all the tools available to support them in facing these new challenges.

Doing that successfully means knowing exactly where we are starting from. Every year, within the SME Performance Review exercise<sup>2</sup>, the Commission performs a thorough assessment of the performance of EU-28 SMEs, which brings evidence to our policy-making.

This Enterprise Europe Network report also adds a valuable contribution: it provides a snapshot of the current situation for SMEs in Europe, based on survey data from businesses using the Network's services. It contains many useful insights because it captures the views of a number of small businesses on how they expect growth in terms of turnover, workforce, market share, prospects for international expansion, and innovation.

The survey's results show this year that SMEs remain cautiously optimistic about their near-term growth. This fits the picture that we are seeing in our economic forecasts.

We in the Commission consider the Enterprise Europe Network as a core part of our future strategy. Supported by the EU under the COSME programme, it is already doing an impressive job. It provides tailored advice, helps European SMEs to innovate, and help connect them up with potential partners so that they can expand in the EU and beyond. More than 220 000 SMEs per year receive help from the Enterprise Europe Network advisers present on the ground in over 60 countries.

I am convinced that the Enterprise Europe Network is well placed to continue to improve the quality, efficiency and relevance of its services, and make an impactful contribution to SMEs' growth in Europe.

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# SME growth outlook 2019-20 - TOP 5 insights

The Enterprise Europe Network's 2019 survey data shows that small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) with international ambitions remain cautiously optimistic about their near-term growth. While optimism levels for turnover, market share and job creation over the coming year slightly fell compared to 2018, they remained broadly consistent with figures for the past two years. This year's star performer was Estonia where SMEs were the most optimistic for the coming 12 months across all three categories of growth. Greece, Sweden and Romania also scored well above average.



#### 1. Turnover prospects remain positive

**59**% of SMEs who internationalise expect to increase their turnover in the next 12 months. While Estonian SMEs (87%) were most confident about increasing their turnover, small businesses in Croatia and Luxembourg (41%) had the lowest expectations.



#### 2. Job creation stays stable

**30% of SMEs seeking to develop their business beyond their national borders expect to create jobs in the next year.** Estonian SMEs (57%) had the highest expectations for job creation while SMEs in Slovakia (6%) were the least optimistic.



#### 3. Cautious optimism for market share

**49% of SMEs looking to expand abroad expect to increase their market share in the next 12 months.** We found the most optimistic SMEs in Estonia (74%). SMEs in Belgium and France (35%) were the most cautious about their near-term growth prospects.



#### 4. Cutting the cost of international expansion

**81%** of small businesses found that the Network helped them to make cost savings when entering new markets. This illustrates the value that of the Network's services to SMEs who often perceive international expansion as a costly due to *lack* of specialised staff to deal with exports, specificity of products to the domestic market and not knowing the rules that have to be followed.



#### 5. Satisfied clients

**88% of clients expressed satisfaction with the Network's services, demonstrating a high level of quality advice and support across the board.** 92% of clients also confirmed they would recommend the Network's services to other businesses.

# Methodology

#### **General**

Survey data was collected between April 2018 and April 2019. Projections relate to the coming 12 months.

Data was submitted electronically to the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EASME) which is responsible for coordinating the EU programme for the Competitiveness of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (COSME), that co-funds the Enterprise Europe Network.

#### Data on SMEs' projections for turnover, job creation and market share

Survey data for EU 28 countries is based on 3639 responses from SMEs who had received advisory, innovation or partnership services from the Enterprise Europe Network.

Country data which represents less than 1% of the client base and fewer than 15 responses per country (Malta, Ireland) appear to be outliers. The data for these countries is not sufficiently representative to provide specific country insights. Where fewer than 15 responses were received for a given question, the data was also considered insufficient to provide an accurate estimate. For the purpose of the report, client base is defined as the number of clients participating in information and training events.

#### **Volume of SMEs benefitting from Network services**

Data covers the EU 28 countries. Data was submitted by Enterprise Europe Network partners and covers a one-year period (2018).

#### **Client satisfaction with Network services**

Data covers all the COSME countries<sup>2</sup>. Data was submitted electronically between April and June 2019 to the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EASME). A total of 2675 clients answered the satisfaction survey.

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
